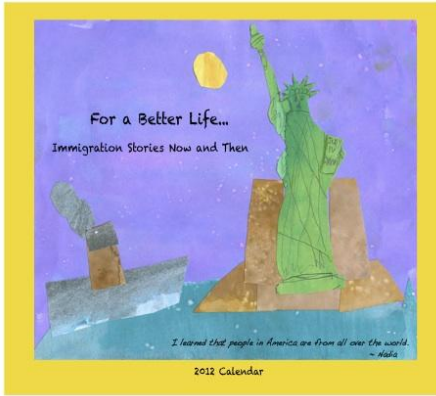


For a Better Life: Immigration Stories Now and Then 2012 Calendar and Our Stories DVD

2012 Calendar

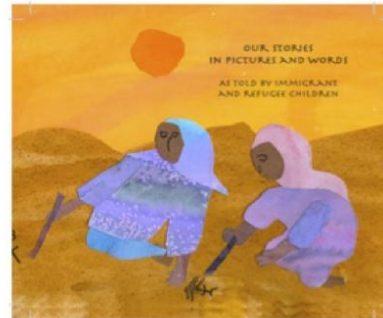


This 2012 calendar includes 13 collage images created by students, grades 3-5, as they reconstructed their family's immigration story—either recent or long ago. There are 18 additional smaller collage images depicting immigration “now and then.” Each calendar image, created using collage made from hand-painted textured papers, is accompanied by an excerpt from that student's family immigration story. This body of work grew out of an Image-Making Within The Writing Process® immigration stories exchange between Webster School's English Language Learner Program in Manchester, NH and Moharimet School in Madbury, NH. Our Stories in Pictures and Words As Told by Immigrant and Refugee Children

This 13-minute DVD provides an overview of English Language Learners, grades 3-5, as they create their own life stories in pictures first and then in words. Many of these students, born and raised in refugee camps, have never even painted before. The art-based literacy process used, Image-Making Within The Writing Process®, utilizes collage made from hand-painted textured papers created by each student. This DVD can be shared with administrators, curriculum coordinators, teachers, pre-service teachers, students, and parents to show how powerful treating words and pictures as equal languages for learning can be.
